Please do not park in the school car park it is for **staff use only**, we do understand that parking at the school can be difficult so please be respectful to each other and our neighbours especially if parking outside their houses. We will send out messages to you if there is going to be anything that will cause any delays to you when we can.

Only press the buzzer if you need to collect your children early and this has been pre-arranged, otherwise the gate will be opened to let you in as soon as we are ready. Putting on coats at home time can take longer on some days than others. As we begin the new school year please remember the importance of having your child's name in their **HATS, COATS, BAGS** and **SHOES** as the children love to dress up and it can be quite difficult working out who's is who's.

PLEASE keep your child away from the gate whilst it opens/closes as it is mechanical and we would not want any accidents to happen. Also, please do not show or allow your child to operate the button or the intercom buzzer - if a child knows 'how to' at these safeguarding points, then they will be able to let themselves out into danger.

Absences -if your child is going to be absent from pre-school please let us know before 8.30am so that we do not order a lunch for them, or unfortunately you may be charged for the cost of the wasted meal. If your son or daughter should be off with sickness they must be kept home for 24 hours from the time of being sick if they have sickness and diarrhoea, then you must keep them home for 48 hours until they are clear from any bugs ect.

Soon you will have received the Pre-School calendar please make a note of any dates that we are closed, if there are any changes we will let you know as they happen and as soon as we can.
